The 1st Of November is the day to honor our ancestors- scribes, saints, martyrs and the heroes of our glorious past.

Before the Liberation this date was served for venerating St. Ivan Rilski. Today he is considered a delegate of God and the patron saint of all Bulgarians.

*The first informal celebration was in Plovdiv in **1909**. In **1922**, the Minister of the National Enlightenment, Stoyan Omarchevski, submitted a proposal for the announcement on November 1st as the day of the Bulgarian national saviors. It was thrown out of the festive calendar, and on November 1st, 1990, at the “Mati Bolgaria” People’s association, the celebration was restored.*

•Petar Hadjiberovich Beron is a Bulgarian enlightenment, scientist, encyclopedist, educator, philosopher, doctor and naturalist.

Born around 1795 (according to other sources, in 1799 or 1800) in Kotel, he lived in Brasov for a while.

•In 1824, with the help of Anton Ivanov, he published "Letter with Different Teachings", or so-called "Fish letter", mistakenly called so because of the dolphin depicted on the cover (in fact, dolphins are mammals, not fish).
